



Cultural Day 2023 Lesson Plan

Collaborative Art Activity - Primary School KS1

Lesson Aims

- *To use a range of materials to design and make products.*
- *To develop a wide range of art techniques.*

Lesson Prep

You will need:

- Images (teacher download)
- Tissue paper (choose desired colours)
- A3 paper
- PVA glue
- Paints (choose desired colours)
- Pencil
- Activity Template (teacher download)

Before the lesson, you will need to print the desired number of worksheets for two or three children to share (printed on A3).

Lesson Starter

Culture and Diversity

- Write culture and diversity on the board.



- Ask children to Think-Pair-Share what it means to them.



- ✚ Why do we celebrate Culture and Diversity?
- ✚ What different Cultures do we have in our class?



- ✚ Ask children to discuss ways to show Culture and Diversity in a picture.
- ✚ Talk about how Cultural day aims to raise cultural awareness and bring people together.



- ✚ Show the image and explain to children that they will be working on a collaborative art piece in pairs or in threes. Demonstrate how to rip and scrunch tissue paper, then how to dip it into glue to put on the paper. Demonstrate how to finger paint (or use any circular tools you wish) to create the painted dots.



Main Activity

Children work in groups to create their final piece. Then, they decide a name for their art work.

Wrapping Up

Bring the children back together and talk about their art pieces.

- ✚ How has each group personalised their artwork?
- ✚ Ask groups to say something they like about another group's work.
