

Cultural Fashion Show



Organize a fashion show where students can showcase traditional clothing from their culture.

🌈 **Cultural songs or music could be shared too.**

This could be organised in the assembly on the day or during the week commencing.

Things to organise before the event.

🌈 **Promote the event**

Create a flyer, possibly by students, highlighting the event indicating the idea behind the fashion show.

Mention the date and time. (This could be a competition where the best flyer gets printed and displayed across school to promote the event).

🌈 **Arrange Logistics**

Determine the location, date, time and space required for the fashion show depending on the size of the school and the number of participants.

🌈 **Plan rehearsals**

Schedule rehearsals to practise the runway walk, coordinate music and lighting. (Cultural music could be chosen if feasible).

🌈 **Coordinate volunteers**

Volunteers would be needed to assist with setup, cleanup, and running of the event.



Additional information

- This could be made into an event where parents could be invited too.
- Also, a ticket price could be charged to generate income for the Parent Council.
- Additionally, refreshments could be bought on site as well.

On the day of the event – 1hr

Welcome Speech: -

- Someone in authority welcomes everyone.
- Share the idea of diversity and inclusion and how it is incorporated as a core value in the school policy.
- Share some statistics of the number of countries that students in the school come from or the number of languages/ dialects that are representative of the students.

Fashion show begins: -

- Participants walk on the ramp.

Close the event

- One of the organisers closes the event.
